

School Council Meeting - 28th May 2010

1. Welcome.

Mrs Willing welcomed everyone to the outside classroom including Mrs Procter. She explained that Joe Cook is away so Rizwan will be chairing the meeting.

2. Matters arising from the last meeting.

Shade from the sun - Mrs Willing explained that we have a new area by the outside classroom that is shaded. She also suggested that we write a letter to parents requesting umbrellas for the decking. Jonathan Marley thought his dad might be able to supply the school with umbrellas.

ACTION - Jonathan to ask his dad about the umbrellas.
