


EYFS: School Closure Work

There is one up at the moment that explains number bonds to ten. Www.themathsfactor.com Carol Vordermon has a selection of maths activities focusing on counting, adding and subtracting. When on your daily exercise look out for house numbers. See what numbers your child can recognise and which you have to help with. See if over time your child can recognise more. We have been practicing recognising numbers 11 to 20. Write them on paper, mix them up, and challenge your child to put them back in order. Don't forget to count backwards! Children often find subtracting numbers difficult, and one of the main reasons for this is that they don't spend enough time counting back. Practice starting from 10, and once they master this try starting from 20.		Go on an alphabet hunt around the house or garden. Make a label for each letter of the alphabet, and then search for something to match each sound! Make a reading hunt. In the last few weeks we were at school the children were really enjoying following reading clues I set up around the room. Write a series of simple clues such as 'on the bin' 'in a cup' and set them up around your house. Below is a photograph of a word matching game. Write body part names of plasters and ask your child to stick them on their teddy.	I have attached a sheet below of images to play a story game. Either cut out or draw your own symbols. Put them in a bag/box and without looking take out 5. Put them in any order, and then use them to make a story! Take turns telling stories, and maybe even have a go at writing them down. Keep a diary of the best thing you have done each day. Children love labelling. Get them to label things around the house. The demand is low because they only have to write one word, but they are often really engaged and end up writing loads!


