Writing



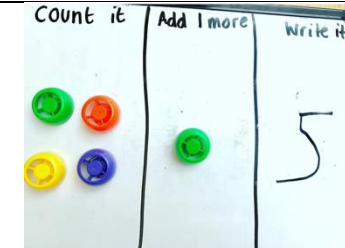
Use flour/salt/sand and a paintbrush or cotton bud to practice writing.
Use letters from papers and magazines to find and build words before having a go at writing them.

Reading

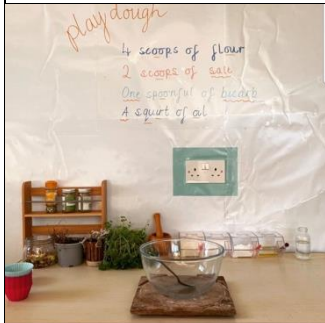


Write words on a plate and cover with rice/flour, and then play a game to find the words.

Maths



Using any small items from around the house, play a game that challenges your child to count, add one more, and then write the final number.



Make some play dough! There is a recipe here, or for something even more simple, we often use 1 cup of flour, 1 cup of salt and half a cup of water.

Make some pictures using things that you find outside in your garden or in the park.

Use an egg box to go on a scavenger hunt. Draw some items on the inside of the lid and challenge your child to find them.
