Is the time am or pm? Can you convert the time to 24 hour and vice versa? > Use a dice to generate addition, subtraction, multiplication and division problems (sums). Check with a calculator. > If you are cooking, try converting the measures of the recipe, e.g. 500g = ½ Kg/ 0.5Kg</p>	<p>Daily Reading 2 fiction books and a non-fiction book will be sent home. Write a book review for one or more of the books (blank format in book sent home) Draw a picture of a character from one of the books you've read and write a short paragraph describing the character.</p> <p>Updated end May 20. > Read a short story , poem or short piece of information aloud to someone else – it could even be a teddy or you could record yourself. > Create a reading corner somewhere in your house – it could be a bedroom, shed, whatever. - Use cushions and make yourself comfortable. What time do you get up? The same or different? What clothes do you wear? Do you go out for exercise? Which routine do you prefer and why? > Write a diary, recording what you do every day. > Write and illustrate a story book for a year 1 or reception child.</p>

Use the cardboard from a cereal box. > Practice drawing your toys or the view outside your window. > Mark out a square or circle in your garden then observe how many creatures visit this area in 5 or 10 minutes. You could repeat this at different times in the day or on different days, to see if there are any patterns- e.g. Are there more when it is sunny or when it is cloudy? > Draw the flowers in your garden. Do you know what their names are?</p>
