If they can compare two or more different items, containers and use estimation first before checking . Money Please allow children to look at all of the coins. Can they make an amount in a variety of ways using different coins? How many ways are there that you could make 9p? etc Time Tell the time to half past and o'clock in and analogue clock. If secure try quarter past and quarter to. Maths Games -Try a maths game to play and test your knowledge . Children can choose from 5-6, or adjust to 4-5 or 6-7 years.
