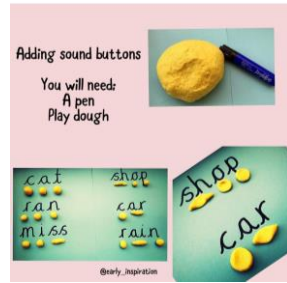


Literacy



Make some sound eating monsters. Then write words on pieces of paper and feed them to the monsters that the sounds match.

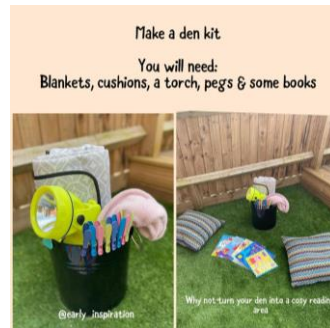
Write words on some paper and use play dough to add the sound buttons. Singular sounds need a circular button and digraphs (such as; ee ar ss sh ch ck) need a longer sound button.

Maths



Make or draw a 10 frame like above. Then use 2 different coloured items to fill the frame, finding different ways to make numbers. Record the additions and subtractions on a piece of paper.

Play bingo! Make some bingo cards, and put all the numbers on small pieces of paper. Take turns pulling the numbers and crossing them off your card.



Use play dough to make a maze. Then find a small ball or a crumpled piece of tinfoil. Using a straw, blow the ball around your maze!

Make a den outside or in your house, use this as a cosy space to read a book, or ask an adult to read a story for you.

Make a bird feeder. Use lolly sticks and glue, and then find somewhere to hang it where you can watch to see what birds you attract.
