Reading

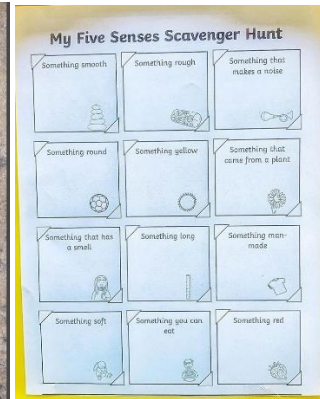


Make some shadow puppets, and use them to retell a story that you know and love. Maybe you could even make up your own!
