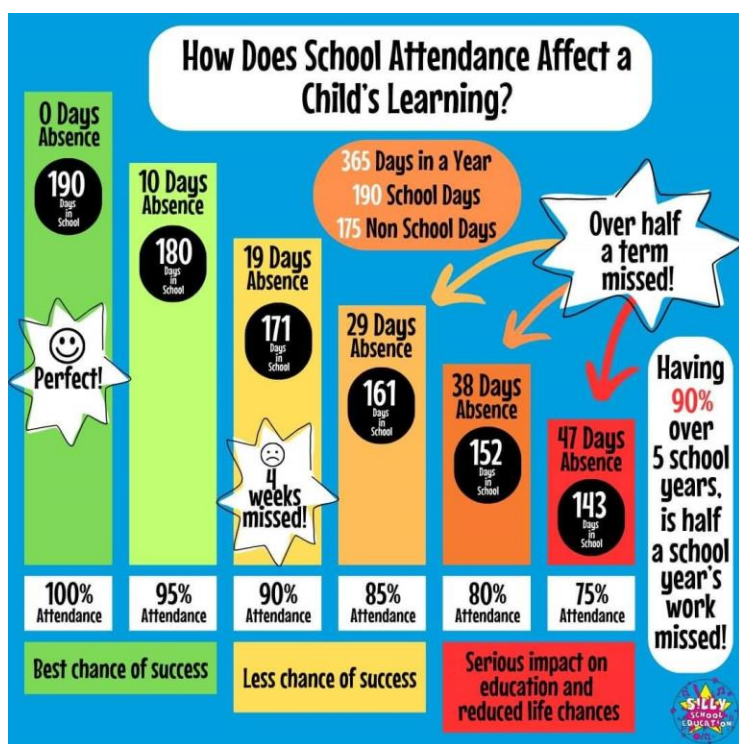

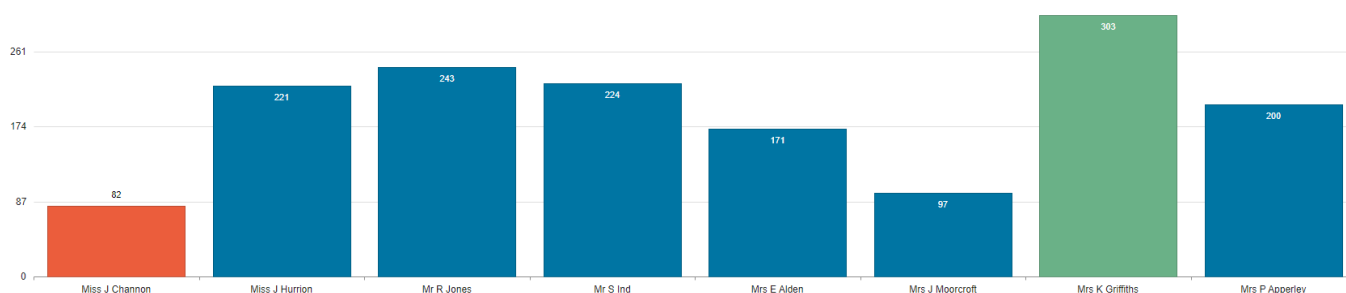

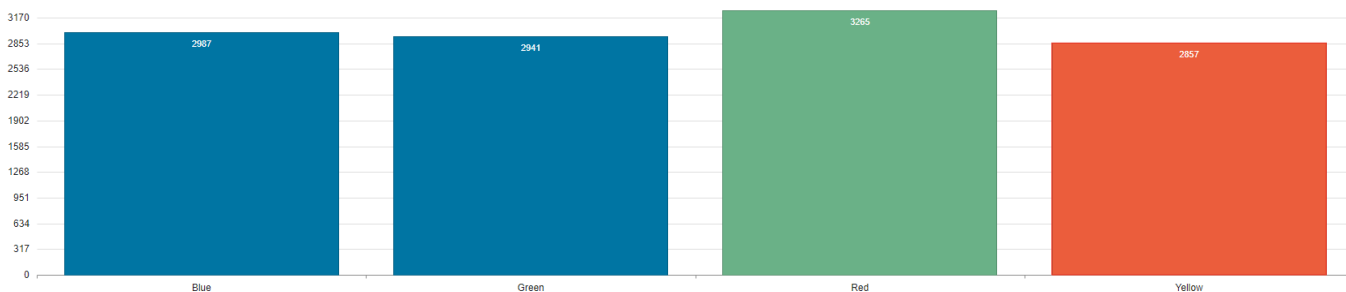
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REWARD POINTS

Congratulations to Year 4, for gaining the most Reward Points this week with 303 points. Go Year 4!

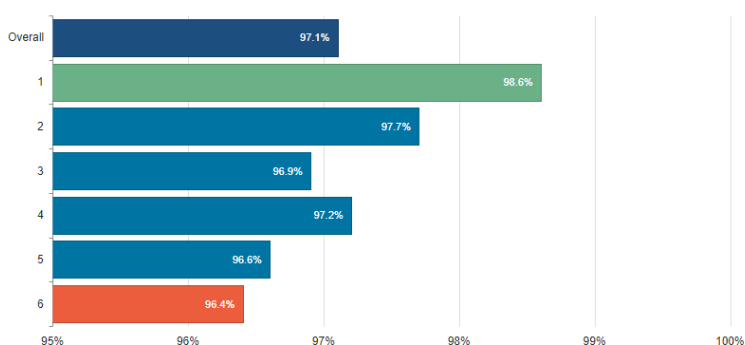


Congratulations also to Red House who remain in the lead with 3265 points!

AFTER SCHOOL CARE – CHANGE OF PROCEDURE

As always, the safety of your child is upmost in our safeguarding procedures and I am keen to keep the site secure whilst we have children on site. From Monday 4th December, we will be changing our procedure for picking your child up from After School Care. At 3.30pm, after school pick up, the school gate will be closed and locked. To pick your child up from After School Care please ring our dedicated telephone number 01730 776736 to let us know you are at the gate and our after-school care staff will bring your child out to the gate. Please note that this telephone number is to be used to collect your child ONLY it is NOT a telephone number that should be used during core hours.

From Monday 4th, we will also be tightening up our procedures for picking your child up from an after-school club, such as football or dance. At the end of the club, staff leading the activity will bring your child to the gate to collect.

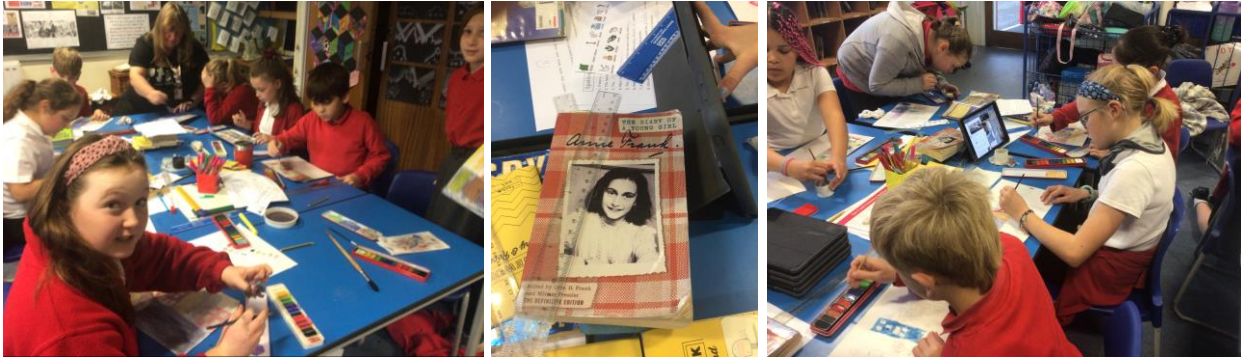

FLU VACCINATIONS – FRIDAY 1st DECEMBER 2023

Reminder information re: Year R-6 Influenza (FLU) vaccinations

The Immunisation Service are coming into school on Friday 1st December to offer your child the Year R-6 Influenza (FLU) vaccinations. You will have already received an email from school with the following information:

- A parent letter - with instructions on how to complete the online consent form, to either consent or refuse this course of vaccinations. This letter also contains your schools unique Cinnamon school code, which you will require in order to submit your child's consent form. Please note there is a cut off time and date for consent completion, which can be found in the letter. This also contains important information on the vaccines and frequently asked questions, to help you and your child reach an informed decision regarding consent.
- Influenza leaflet from Public Health England - to be shared with your child.
- The online consent form is available for completion until 11am four working days before the 1st December. However, if you have any difficulties completing this online form, please contact your local Immunisation team before the cut-off date, using the telephone number provided below. If you miss the cut off time to complete the consent form, you will be able to call the immunisation team on 01273 696011 ext. 8100 where you can give verbal consent. We will not be able to vaccinate your child in school on the day of the vaccination session if no consent has been given.

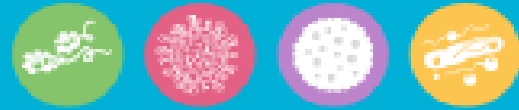
