I hope that you and your families are well. As we strive to improve the quality of communication with parents and carers, I would like to remind you that we have now fully implemented the Bromcom 'My Child at School' system in the school and we would like all parents and carers to access their child's record using the 'My Child at School' web portal and mobile app – MCAS.

Our aim is for this system to become the backbone of our communications with parents and carers and want it to become the main platform used in all communications with you on all school matters. It is important that everyone uses this system to access key information about their son/daughter's learning experience. The MCAS app will support your child's learning by allowing us to keep you informed, message you and allow you to receive information from the school about your child. Bookings for wrap around care (breakfast club and after school care), clubs, trips and parents evenings are now managed via the app.





The mobile app, which is available for both IOS and Android devices, also allow us to contact you via app notifications in just the same way as the current text system, but without the cost of each message and so helping to protect school finances, and will also alleviate the amount of emails and letters that we send home. To facilitate this users must allow notifications from the app via the settings app on your phone. To help

Basic information, timetable, attendance messages, clubs, wrap wround care and parents evenings are available in MCAS and we will be making further pages, such as school reports and behaviour available to all users in the coming months. 



Congratulations to Hazel Class for gaining the most Reward Points this week with 436 points. Well done Hazel Class!




Arun House are in the lead this week with 1254 points!




Here at F.23 we are passionate about delivering a high standard of teaching & choreography throughout different areas of performing arts, and love to see our students build confidence and creativity through movement.




