Many of our school operations have now moved to a more automated system on MCAS, such as Breakfast and After School Care, Trips and general contact details. From now Parents Evenings will only be able to be booked via the MCAS app. Our March Parents Consultations are now uploaded to the MCAS app and booking will open on the 1st day of March. This seems quite early notice but I feel it worthy as it gives you all time to download the app and make sure it is working for you, particularly as the only way to book clubs for your children is to log on to the app.

UNIFORM REMINDERS

As we start the new year I think it appropriate to remind everyone of our uniform requirements. I have noticed a number of non-uniform items coming into school recently, particularly rings, jewellery and various coloured hoodies. Please take a look at our uniform requirements below.

Uniform:

Girls White blouse or polo shirt

School sweatshirt/cardigan or red jumper/cardigan

Grey/Black skirt or pinafore dress.

Grey/Black trousers

Summer dresses are red/white striped or checked

Red school fleece

Boys White shirt or polo shirt

School sweatshirt or red jumper

Grey/Black trousers/shorts

Red school fleece

P.E.Kit:

Boys and Girls Plimsolls

Black shorts

House coloured (or white) PE top

Boot bag

Hair, Jewellery etc. No jewellery allowed except for a watch and only small, plain studs if

children have pierced ears. These need to be covered with tape

during PE.

Watches – to be analogue or digital. No smart watches. Fitbits are

allowed.

Hair accessories are to be kept to a discreet minimum.

Dyed hair or shaved tramlines are not allowed.

Nail varnish should not be worn in school.

Mobile Phones

Only Year 5 and 6 pupils may bring phones to school but this is at their own risk. However, the pupil must agree to hand the phone into an adult during school hours. The school will not accept responsibility for the phone at any point.

After agreement with the school, other pupils are allowed to bring a mobile to school in certain circumstances. For instance, travelling to school by themselves and young carers who need to be contactable.

If pupils are allowed to bring phones to school they must be handed to the school office on arrival, or to the class teacher.

Pupils are not permitted to access their phones during the day unless there are extenuating circumstances. If phones are seen being used in school they will be confiscated and will need to be collected from the school office at the end of the day.

If you wish your child to bring a mobile to school you will need to get a mobile agreement from the office and return it signed.





