At last the sun has arrived and what a difference it makes!

So, SATs week has arrived! The tests are timetabled from Monday 13<sup>th</sup> May to Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> May

**Monday** - English grammar, punctuation and spelling test.

**Tuesday** - English reading test

**Wednesday** - Paper 1 – Arithmetic, Paper 2 – Maths Reasoning

**Thursday** - Paper 3 – Maths Reasoning

All Year 6 pupils are invited to have breakfast at school on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday during SATs week. The children should arrive at 8.45am every morning to enjoy breakfast with us, which we will provide free of charge. We have found in the past that the children are more settled for the tests if they arrive on time, have breakfast with us and have an opportunity to discuss last minute concerns and settle any nerves.

Please help your child by encouraging them to do a sensible amount of last-minute revision but also to find time to exercise, relax and to get plenty of sleep up to and during the week. The test week can be very tiring for the children so please ensure that they are able to get enough sleep during the week, please try to avoid late nights as the children then find it hard to concentrate in the mornings.

In the unlikely event that children are mildly unwell, we would encourage them to come in to school to complete the tests and they may leave afterwards if necessary.

On Thursday afternoon we have arranged for an ice cream van to visit school to treat our Year 6 SATs children. The ice cream van will be parked on the lower playground during pick up at the end of the day if you wish to purchase an ice cream.



As I mentioned last week our children have been working hard creating a new school prayer and candle. This Sunday both the prayer and candle will be dedicated by the Bishop of Horsham during Holy Communion at Midhurst Parish Church. During the service, Sienna Olkinuora and Edward Hutchings from Oak Class will be reading the lessons and also processing the candle to the alter. If you are able to join us for the service of dedication please do. The service of Holy Communion starts at 10.30am.

### **CELEBRATE NATIONAL NUMERACY DAY WITH THE WEST SUSSEX ADULT LEARNING SERVICE**

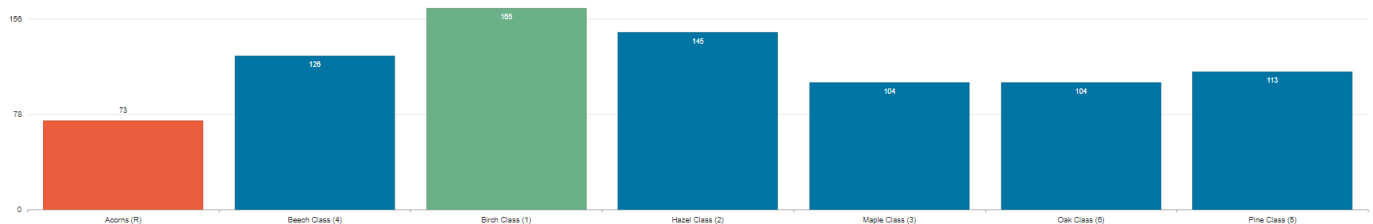

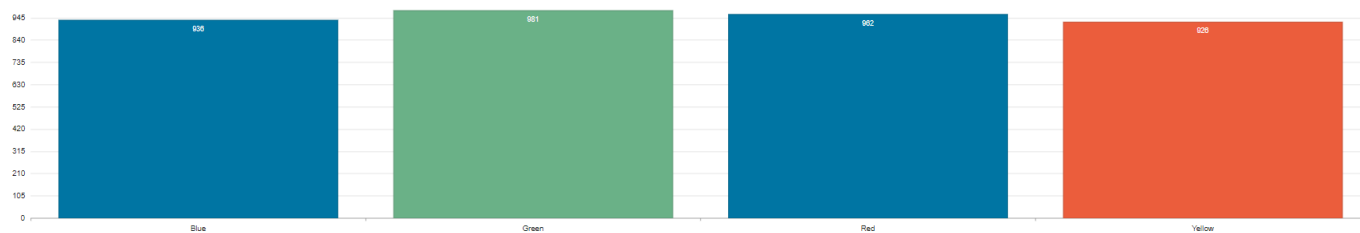

Congratulations to Birch Class for gaining the most Reward Points this week with 165 points. Well done Birch Class!



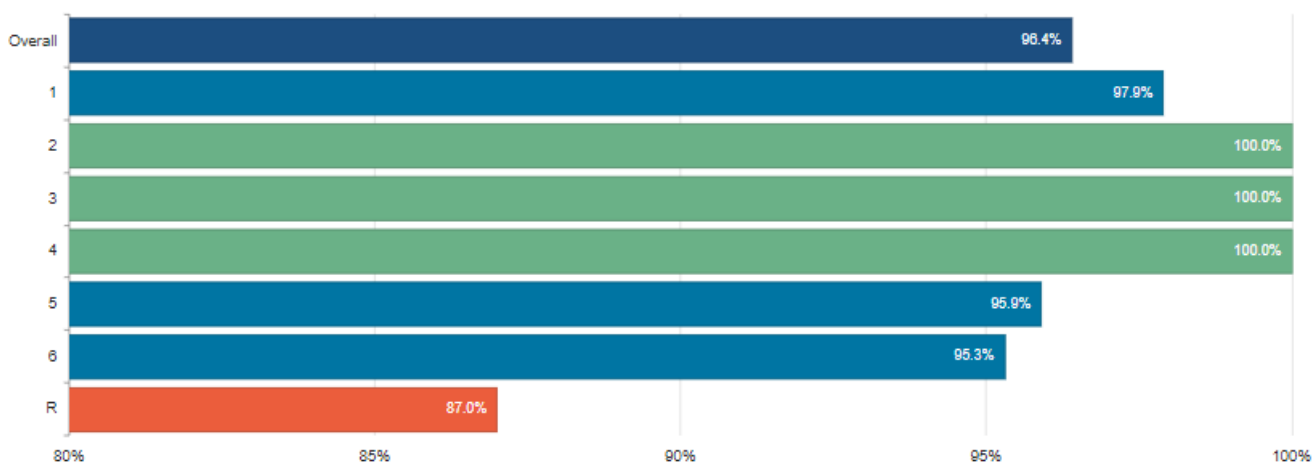
Rother House are currently in the lead with 981 points!

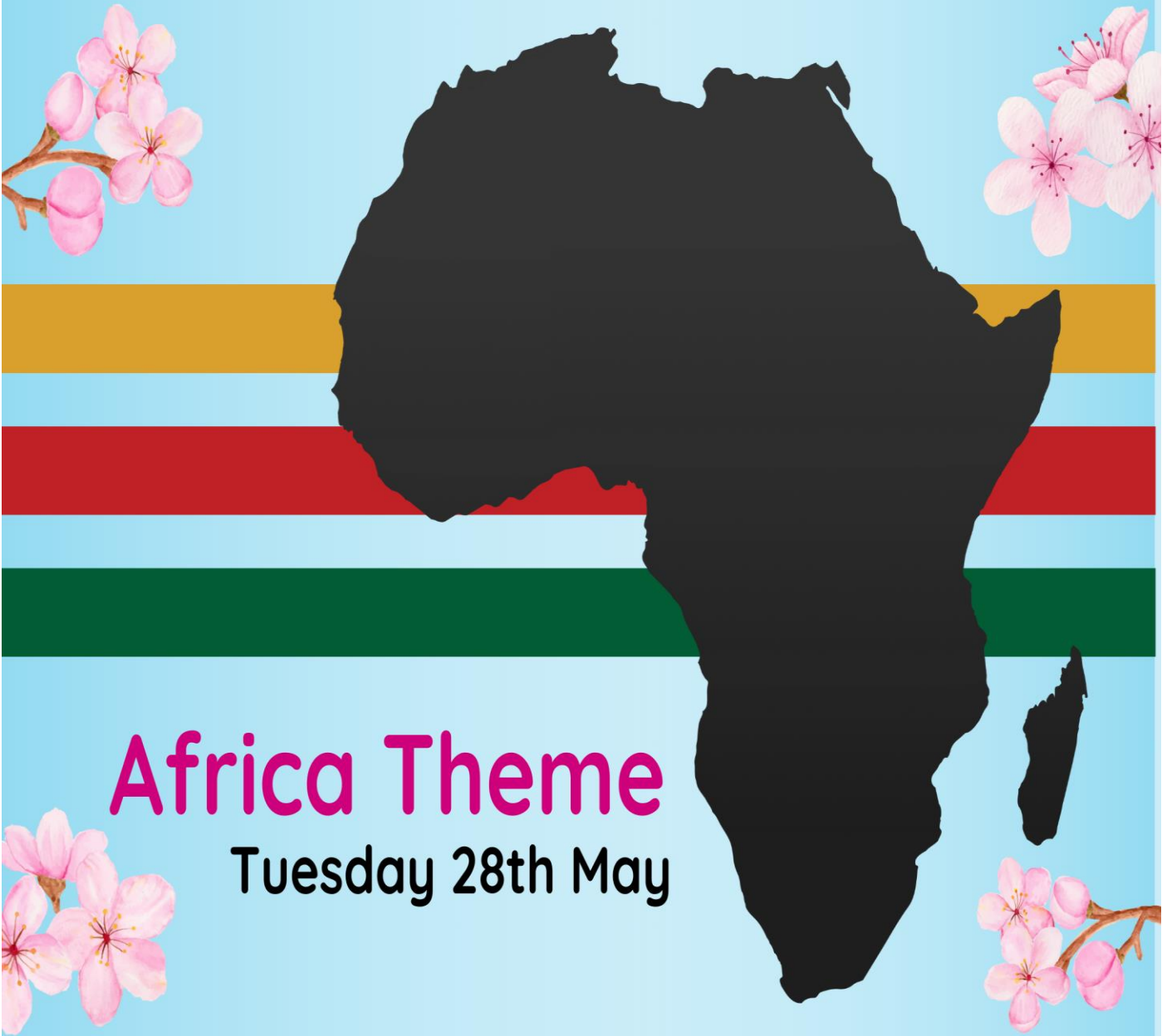

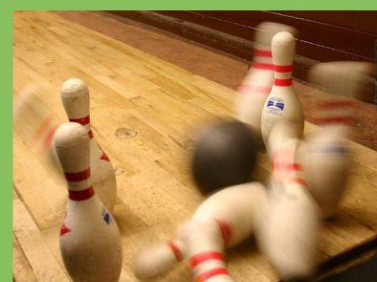
A chance to be creative this National Creativity Day. Come along and let your creativity flow! Try out different media, including paint, charcoal, pen and ink, collage.
