Dear Parents

Following a recent meeting of the full governing body, I would like to share with you our new parental code of conduct. You will receive the code of conduct via email.

We use the term 'parent' to refer to anyone with parental responsibility for a pupil, and anyone caring for a child (including grandparents and child-minders).

At Midhurst CofE Primary we are committed to working in partnership with you to support your child's learning. In our school we aim to create a safe, respectful and inclusive environment for children, staff and parents. To help us do this, we set clear expectations and guidelines on behaviour for all members of our community. This includes staff (through the staff code of conduct), pupils (through our behaviour policy), and parents (through the parental code of conduct).

We request and expect parents and other visitors to:

- Respect the ethos, vision and values of our school
- Treat all members of the school community with respect, with regards to both communications and behaviour
- Refrain from any behaviours or language which might be deemed to be aggressive, abusive or insulting, when on school premises.

Where parental conduct falls short of our expectations, the school will respond in a proportional way. The final decision for how to respond to breaches of this code of conduct rests with the headteacher.

EXTENDED WRAPAROUND CARE AVAILABLE FROM JANUARY 2025



We are really excited to share that from January 2025 we will be offering wraparound care at our breakfast and after school clubs from 7.55am till 6pm. As you know, the government is committed to supporting parents to return to work once their children are in full-time education, and our recent parent survey showed there would be plenty of demand at MPS over the next few years.

We have added more places at breakfast club, and our lovely after school club staff, Zoe and Margaret, have agreed to look after the children till 6pm, so you can be confident there will always be a place for your child when you need it. You will be able to start booking for January from Monday 9 December, so look out for the new sessions.

Don't forget that you can get help paying for your wraparound care by setting up a Tax-Free Childcare account – for every £8 you pay into the account, the government adds £2 – and our clubs are registered with the scheme so you can use the money to pay for your sessions. HAZEL CLASS VISIT MIDHURST PARISH CHURCH




As part of our RE curriculum, classes will often go to the Parish Church to take part in lessons led by Rev. Marcus, our school chaplain.


Here are Hazel Class taking part in a lesson on Christian traditions, particularly Christening – what happens in a Christening Service and what the tradition means.

Congratulations to Oak Class for gaining the most Reward Points this week with 287 points. Well done Oak Class!




Congratulations to Rother House who are currently in the lead with 3834 pts.
