PARKING PERMITS AVAILABLE NOW!

Do you drive your children to school? Did you know we have an arrangement to allow free parking in The Grange car park to cover drop off and collection times? You just keep your permit in your car and make sure it's on the dashboard while you walk across to school. ROADWORKS NOTIFICATION

Before making a booking, you will need to either, log into your account or, create one using your child's existing HAF code. This is the same code you will have used to book your HAF place previously. If you have recently registered for benefits related free school meals, you will find your HAF code on the award letter sent to you by the Free School Meal team. You may be able to find your HAF code by asking your child's school office or alternatively contact us on haf@westsussex.gov.uk

HAF eligible children will be able to book the following number of sessions;

Easter – 4 sessions

Summer – 16 sessions

Winter – 4 sessions

These sessions will remain free of charge if you are accessing benefits related free school meals. Each session will include a free nutritious meal.





Congratulations to Acorn Class for gaining the most Reward Points this week with 189 points. Well done Acorn Class




Rother House remain in the lead this week with 13297 points so far this year.


